

For more than a century, The Church of Jesus Christ of Latter-day Saints has partnered with councils to lead boys on the path that keeps them close to their families and the Church as they develop the qualities of citizenship, character, and fitness through the aims and methods of the Boy Scouts of America.

The Orange County Council spends \$300 to fund ONE young man for one year in Scouting. This cost represents council services and support, camp operations, and outreach programs. Each year we ask our members to donate to the Scouting program to help offset these expenses.

Of the 693 Eagle Scouts in 2016, 124 were LDS young men.


#### This past year, the Orange County Council:
