

The Leadership and Youth Development Program at the IROEC will provide middle school, high school, and collegiate students with the opportunity to advance their leadership capacity of peers at school, with their friends and family, and in their communities. Our enthusiastic and knowledgeable staff will facilitate a memorable, immersive experience which builds on Orange County Department of Education's 'The Whole Child' strategic priority. Our programs are designed to equip student leaders to 'lead the nation in college and career readiness,' and improve their proficiency in 'critical thinking, communication, collaboration, and character.'



**Icebreakers and Initiatives** // What better way to get to know your teammates or find out new things about them than to play a fun game with a purpose? Staff will design the best order of initiatives and warm-ups throughout the whole Leadership Program experience. Student leaders will do some of these each program day, enabling them to bond as a tight-knit group, learn about their personal strengths and room for improvement, all while having fun!

**Challenge Course** // In this cooperative, group setting it will be important for each individual to contribute to the whole team's success. Because staff members purposefully scaffold the difficulty of the activities on the course, each team member will be able to thrive while overcoming individual fears, while helping their team think creatively.
